

MEMBERSHIP RECRUITER AWARD

The IEA Membership Recruiter Award is presented to a person annually who has exhibited leadership skills in the area of membership recruitment and retention. The recipient of this award is selected on the basis of sustained efforts in the area of membership recruitment and retention.

Guidelines for Selection:

1. The award shall go to a person or persons who have made a special and unique contribution to membership recruitment and retention and particularly in the last year.
2. The award shall normally be limited to one award annually.
3. Nominations may come from the local and region level.
4. No more than one nominee will be accepted from any one source.
5. The Awards Subcommittee of the Board of Directors will screen nominations submitted to the Board. The awards subcommittee shall make a recommendation to the Board of Directors at its winter meeting. The Board of Directors shall act upon the recommendation at that meeting.
6. The award shall be given annually at the IEA Delegate Assembly.
7. The award shall be given only if an acceptable nominee is selected.
8. Information about the outstanding membership recruiter award shall be published at least once each year.
9. The award shall consist of an appropriate plaque on which the name of the recipient shall be engraved. In addition, payment of the IEA membership dues shall be paid for one award recipient for the ensuing year.
10. Travel including airfare, hotel up to \$70.00 and \$20.00 for food shall be allotted to one award recipient if recipient lives out of the Treasure Valley, to attend the IEA Award Ceremony at Delegate Assembly. (07)
